


VIK 2018 OBTAINED 97 POINTS FROM COLIN HAY

After releasing its most iconic wine, VIK, on La Place de Bordeaux last March, Viña VIK is now to offer a limited release of VIK 2018 vintage: only 50 double-magnums of the highly rated wine as NFTs or only available at the Winery in Millahue, Chile and R.E.D. Society Members.*



VIK 2018 (Cachapoal Valley, Chile; 75% Cabernet Sauvignon; 25% Cabernet Franc; aged for 20 months in French oak barrels and for 6 months in Barroir barrels; 14.5% alcohol).

Rather more of a vin de garde than the 2019, though highly accessible already, this will benefit very much from being in a larger format such as a double magnum. This is lovely. Immediately expressive aromatically with a delightful combination of wild herbs, crushed petals and richer, deeper spicier notes accentuating the red stone fruit. There's a little tapenade, a waft of wood smoke and a touch of clove, cinnamon and vanilla pod. The tannins are hyper-refined and that gives this a subtle elegance on the palate, disguising very well the considerable power and aging potential. Long and savoury on the finish, this is truly excellent. 97.
